Privacy Policy for Equilibrado Equestrian

At Equilibrado Equestrian, we are committed to protecting your privacy and ensuring that your personal information is handled in a safe and responsible manner. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and protect your personal information when you visit our website and use our online training courses ("Courses"). By accessing or using our website and Courses, you agree to the terms outlined in this Privacy Policy.

This policy applies to users worldwide, including residents of the European Union (EU), the United States, Canada, and other international locations.

1. Information We Collect

We collect the following types of personal information when you interact with our website or use our Courses:

a. Personal Information

When you register for an account, purchase a course, or contact us, we may collect the following personal information:

- Name
- Email address

b. Usage Data

- Device and network information (e.g., operating system, device type)

c. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We use cookies, web beacons, and similar tracking technologies to improve your experience on our website. These technologies help us:

- Analyze how you use our website
- Remember your preferences and login details
- Personalize content and advertisements

• Track the effectiveness of our marketing campaigns

You can control or disable cookies through your browser settings, but some features of our website may not function properly if cookies are disabled.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect for the following purposes:

- To provide, maintain, and improve our online training courses
- To process transactions and manage your account
- To communicate with you regarding Course updates, promotions, and customer service inquiries
- To personalize your experience and recommend relevant content
- To analyze and improve the performance of our website and Courses
- To ensure the security and integrity of our website and services
- To comply with legal obligations and enforce our agreements

3. How We Share Your Information

We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal information. However, we may share your information in the following circumstances:

a. Service Providers

We may share your information with trusted third-party service providers who help us operate our website, process payments, provide customer support, or analyze website performance. These service providers are contractually obligated to protect your personal information and only use it to perform services on our behalf.

b. Legal Compliance

We may disclose your personal information if required to do so by law, such as in response to a subpoena, court order, or other legal request, or to protect our rights, property, or safety, or that of others.

c. Business Transfers

If we are involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, your personal information may be transferred as part of that transaction. We will notify you if your information is subject to a different privacy policy.

4. Data Security

We take reasonable precautions to protect your personal information from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. These measures include administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to secure your data. However, please be aware that no data transmission over the internet or electronic storage method is 100% secure, and we cannot guarantee the absolute security of your personal information.

5. Your Rights and Choices

Depending on your location, you may have certain rights regarding your personal information. These include:

a. Canadian Residents (PIPEDA Compliance)

Under Canada's Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (PIPEDA), Canadian residents have the right to:

- Request access to their personal information
- Request corrections to inaccurate or incomplete information
- Withdraw consent at any time (if we rely on consent for processing)
- Request deletion of their personal data in certain situations

b. European Union (EU) Residents (GDPR Compliance)

If you are located in the EU, you have the following rights under the **General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)**:

- Right to rectification: You can request corrections to your data if it's inaccurate or incomplete.

- Request the deletion of your personal information
- Opt-out of the sale of your personal information (although we do not sell personal data)
